

CONCERTO COMPETITION

The BNMO will present its unique *PRODIGIEM 2* Concerto Competition on April 30, 2025, at the Burlington Performing Arts Centre Main Stage.

The **PRODIGIEM 2 Concerto Competition** is open to young, prodigious Woodwind, Brass, and Vocal performers ages 8 to 18. Performers must be residents of Canada.

The cross-genre competition includes Classical, Jazz, Pop, Broadway and Rock.

Final winners of the competition will be invited to perform live with the Burlington New Millennium Orchestra on April 30, 2025.

Round One:

Opens October 16, 2024 Closes December 6, 2024, 5:00 pm

Interested performers are invited to audition for the first round of the competition by submitting video performances and or links directly to Maestro Charles Cozens. These performances must be non-edited with good fidelity.

Selected performers moving onto Round Two will be notified no later than December 20, 2024

Round Two:

Sunday, February 9, 2025, Steinway Gallery, Mississauga (exact times to be determined)

Selected performers from Round One will be invited to perform live at the Steinway Gallery in Mississauga, Ontario, on Sunday Feb 9, 2025. Adjudication will be by a panel of jurors headed by BNMO Maestro Charles Cozens.

Each performer will be allowed 10 minutes of performance time. Repertoire for each performer should be solidified by January 9, 2025. Sheet music must be supplied to the juror committee by January 15, 2025

Candidates may supply their own accompanist, but a BNMO accompanist will be available all day. A total of 6 winning candidates will be selected from Round 2 and notified the same day.

Selected performers must be available for an orchestra rehearsal in the afternoon and an evening performance on Wednesday, April 30, 2025

Round Three:

Performance April 30, 2025, with the BNMO

Performers will be awarded a first, second and third prize. The other 3 performers will receive an award of merit and an honorarium.

Cogeco TV will record the concert program for Cable broadcast.
